DMG/MAJ/1st/RULES-2013/PART-I/2908

In exercise of the powers conferred by the section 23C of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby amends Goa (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation of Minerals) Rules, 2013 namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation of Minerals) (First Amendment) Rules, 2014.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of Rule 3.*— In Rule 3 of the Goa (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation of Minerals) Rules, 2013, after the second proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

“Provided also that no registration as aforesaid will be insisted only for participating in e-auction of excavated mineral ore lying in different mines/stockyards/jetties/ports in the State of Goa, whenever Government desires to sell ore as a special measures.”
