IN exercise of the powers under section 23C of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Act no. 67 of 1957), *read* with section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Act no. 10 of 1897) the Governor is pleased to make the following rules, with a *view* to amending the Uttar Pradesh Minerals (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Transportation and Storage) Rules, 2018.

THE UTTAR PRADESH MINERALS (PREVENTION OF ILLEGAL MINING,  
TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE) (SECOND AMENDMENT) RULES, 2020

Short title and  
commencement

1. (1) These rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Minerals (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Transportation and Storage) (Second Amendment) Rules, 2020.

(2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the *Gazette*.

Amendment of  
rule 4

2. In the Uttar Pradesh Minerals (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Transportation and Storage) Rules, 2018 *for* sub-rule (1) of rule 4 set out in column-I below, the sub-rule as set out in column-II shall be *substituted*, namely:-

COLUMN-I

(Existing sub-rule)

4 Eligibility for grant of licence and storage of minerals –

(1) Every Person shall be eligible for grant of license except the following person:-

(a) a person who is not an Indian National;

(b) a company which is not the ambit of Companies Act, 2013;

(c) a person who is convicted by a court;

(d) a person whose license has been cancelled for violation of terms and conditions of a previous licence;

(e) lessee in case of river bed minerals for the concerned district.

COLUMN-II

(Sub-rule as hereby substituted)

4 Eligibility for grant of licence and storage of minerals –

(1) Every Person shall be eligible for grant of license except the following person:-

(a) a person who is not an Indian National;

(b) a company which is not in the ambit of Companies Act, 2013;

(c) a person who is convicted by a court;

(d) a person whose license has been cancelled for violation of terms and conditions of a previous licence;

(e) lessee in case of river bed minerals for the concerned district **except in the storage license period ending on December 31, 2020, owing to conditions arising from Covid-19 pandemic :**
