Sub:- Acquisition of lands for field channels and Hikkal channelclarification

Under Sections 15 and 16 of the Mysore Irrigation Act, 1965.

I am directed to state that whenever the lands are required for filed channels and Hikkal Channels, in any area for supply of water for Irrigation work, proposals are sent to Government under the Land Acquisition Act. In these cases action has to be taken as per the provisions of Sections 15 and 16 of the Mysore Irrigation Act, 1965.

The powers are vested with the Deputy Commissioners under Section 16 of the Mysore Irrigation Act to proceed to take possession of the lands for the purpose, under the provisions of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 as if a declaration has been issued by the State Government for the acquisition thereof under Section 6 of that Act and as if the State Government had thereupon directed the Deputy Commissioner to take order for the acquisition of such land under Sec.7 of the said Act and as if the State Government had issued orders for immediate possession being taken under Section 17 of the said Act.

In the above circumstances it is directed that action should be taken under Sections 15 and 16 of the Mysore Irrigation Act, 1965 (Mysore Act 16 of 1965); whenever the lands are required for field channels and Hikkal channels.
